



Hania is Jewish, and her parents lose their jobs in the growing climate of hostility. With no money and no prospects for the future, her family decides to emigrate. But the girl does not want to leave.

After Hania and Janek's colleagues are expelled from university and the government censors an upcoming theatrical production, the two decide to act. Compelled by their love, they participate in a protest to defend freedom of the theatre and freedom of speech, but police brutality and violence ensue, separating the young couple and threatening their future together.

This dramatic love story offers a heady convergence of romance, history and politics in a rarely told story of antisemitism in 1960s communist Poland.

In 1998, graduate student Teddy Katz published his Masters thesis about a massacre that allegedly took place in the village of Tantura in 1948. Initially received with distinction, his work was later discredited, but 140 hours of audio testimonies remain. Schwartz confronts former Israeli soldiers of the Alexandroni Brigade, now in their 90s, with these tapes. What emerges are complicated and sometimes contradictory accounts that call into question the nature of memory, testimony and even archival footage that has long been part of Israel's founding myth.

In 2009, Glenn Kurtz discovered a crumbling 16mm colour home movie in his parents' closet — amateur footage his grandfather David shot in 1938 on a European holiday. The film included three minutes of what would turn out to be the only known footage of the predominantly Jewish town of Nasielsk, Poland — David Kurtz's birthplace — just one year before the Nazi occupation would destroy the community, leaving fewer than 100 survivors.






