Moriah College does not discriminate against staff employed or to be employed on the basis of their sexuality, gender or sexual preferences. We expect staff to act publicly in a manner that is not inconsistent with the ethos, tenets and values of the school.

Moriah College does not discriminate against students or applicants for enrolment on the basis of their sexuality or their sexual preferences.

Moriah College has never relied on the legislative exemptions contained in the Sex Discrimination Act and welcomes the Senate Legal and Constitutional Affairs References Committee's recent recommendations to prohibit faith-based educational institutions from discriminating against students or staff members on the basis of sexual orientation, gender identity or relationship status.
